WHAT IS ENTERPRENEETS PROJECT?

- Small Scale Partnership in the field of youth
- Empowering young female
 NEETs by providing them with
 entrepreneurial skills in the
 fields of social
 entrepreneurship, intercultural
 communication, project
 management, and digital and
 ICT skills.
- Combatting the overrepresentation of women in the NEET category, and their underrepresentation as entrepreneurs. The main strategy: non-formal education (NFE).
- Exchange of good practices, aimed at producing a toolkit that can be used across the EU in fostering entrepreneurship.

AIMS OF THE PROJECT MEET THE

The long-term end result is the development of entrepreneurial skills of young women belonging to the NEET group, and, therefore, to increase their social inclusion and their employability.

The collection of good practices from the Consortium of partners in an initial research will lead to a creation of the Toolkit that will be able to be deployed in any youth organisation working with a similar target group.

MEET THE CONSORTIUM

Kick-off meeting of the project took place 30th of May 2023 in Milan, Italy, Partners were hosted by the project coordiating partner L'orma. Partners of the project include NGO **NEST Berlin. ADEL Slovakia** and Bulgarian Sports **Development Association.** Partners agreed on the first steps of the project. The first task was to conduct Reseach among the female NEETs. NGOs and educational institutions working with them. The Research will serve as a base in order to target further activities of the project.

PROJECT OUTPUTS

Research on good practices for entrepreneurial activation of female NEETs

Each partner conducted research within their country, based on a pre-determined research methodology.

The research focuses on three areas:

- 1. Good practices in entrepreneurship education with a focus on empowering NEETs
- 2. Identification of best entrepreneur profiles and the related set of competences needed to start and manage a business activity
- 3. Cross-country research aimed at the identification of existing entrepreneurial upskilling need s of young women, especially belonging to the NEETgroup.

Thematic Toolkit

This activity will be focused on the production of 4 thematic toolkits in the area of expertise of each partner, with the implementation of the best practices identified in the research phase. The toolkits, in their initial form, will be used and validated by youth workers in the joint staff training.

Later, the toolkits will be improved and adjusted to do-it-yourself non-formal approach, so it will be possible to use them by the NEETs themselves. The toolkits will contain tools and activities based on non-formal education.
